As discussed during our meeting on June 17, 2024, The Chemours Company FC, LLC (Chemours) is requesting a technical modification to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Environmental Resource Permit (Permit No. MMR_137482-018) to update the estimated acres that may be in various stages of the mining process within the active mining areas. This requested technical modification will update the estimated 160 acres (80 acres per Mobile Mining Unit (MMU)) to an estimated 280 acres (140 acres per MMU). Once Chemours began operations it was found that the originally estimated 160 acres were insufficient to conduct all necessary stages of the mining process using this updated mining methodology.

The requested modification will not result in any adverse effects to the current stormwater management plan as provide in Attachment 2 (Stormwater Management Report) of the Trail Ridge South Application.
